



St Thomas Aquinas Behaviour Management Plan

At St Thomas Aquinas School we believe that we should live through our Christian values. Our Christian values relate directly to restorative practices, which we use effectively at our school. Our school values are: Compassion, Hospitality and Social Justice, Excellence, Service.

Classroom Steps system:

- Step 1 Verbal/Non verbal warning
- Step 2 Name on board - warning
- Step 3 Time out - Minutes related to age
- Step 4 Time out - Reflection sheet in another classroom
- Step 5 Time out - Reflection sheet discussed with Principal/Teacher - contact parents

Please note: Restorative conversation will happen when adult deems necessary.

If behaviour is a major behaviour this needs to be recorded on MUSAC.

Out of Classroom Steps system:

- Step 1 Redirection of undesirable behaviour
- Step 2 Walk with adult and have restorative conversation
- Step 3 Time out - allocated area (steps outside office)
- Step 4 Time out - Reflection sheet with Principal
- Step 5 Contact parents for conference

Any major behaviour children will be placed immediately on Step 4 and will need to contact their parents.

All major behaviours will be recorded on MUSAC.
